

Indoor & Outdoor Visitation is Suspended

Applicable to: facilities with outbreak that are waiting for the 1st round of testing results.

The Illinois Department of Public Health (“IDPH”) and Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (“CMS”) have recently released guidance for Skilled Nursing Facilities and Other Long-Term Care Facilities to follow, regarding COVID-19 and re-introducing group activities and visitation.

Per IDPH’s Reopening Plan for Skilled Nursing Facilities and Other Long-Term Care Facilities **in person visitations are currently suspended** at Bella Terra Bloomingdale, except for specific circumstances as laid out in IDPH’s and CMS’ guidelines and regulations, which may change from time to time. Additionally, group dining and activities may be restricted, and salon services will be suspended.
